TIMEBANKING HISTORY


Life works better with informal supports and community connections

FTB Team helps a person, family/group, or organization with a service activity.

Perform a Service Together

- Cook a meal, prepare food
- Write a notecard or essay
- · Participate in park clean-up
- · Help at library or foodbank

Experience Something Together

- Obtain Government ID
- Participate in Talent Show
- Join a club

Learn Something Together

- Take photography course
- · Learn CPR or first aid
- · Achieve an exercise goal
- Attend a town meeting

FTB has 2 Rules:


- 1. FTB team completes service activity.
- 2. FTB team tracks their service activity with FTB Coordinator.

Family earns 1 credit for each hour of service. At 10 credits family receives FTB gift card.
